# LANGUAGE REGIMEN OF THE STUDENT CONFERENCE AND SUBMISSION OF ARTICLES

The languages used for the student conference presentations are Lithuanian and English. The presentation must be submitted as an MS PowerPoint file. The article can be written in Lithuanian or English. The abstract must be in English.

Please submit the presentations to the conference organisers by 06.11.2023, sending them to konferencija@kolpingokolegija.lt. The conference participants must implement necessary corrections to their presentations subject to the commission's feedback. The duration of the presentation is 7 to 10 minutes.



#### ARTICLE STRUCTURE

Title (centred, written in capital letters, bold, 14 pt font).

Author's name (centred, written in capital letters, in bold, italic, 12 pt font).

Representative organisation (centred, written in normal, 12 pt font).

Advisor (professor) (centred, written in normal, 12 pt

Abstract (in Lithuanian and English) (up to 100 words, written in italia, 11 pt font). The English version of the abstract must include the title, the organisation, the author, and the abstract text).

Introduction, chapters, conclusions (the title written in **bold**, the other text written in normal, 12 pt font, left alignment, including 1 cm indent).

Tables (the title centred, written in **bold**, 10 pt font, displayed above the table, numbered in Arabic numerals; table data written in normal, 10 pt font).

Figures (the title centred, written in **bold**, 10 pt font, displayed below the figure).

Formulas (formulas compiled using the MS Word formulas editor, written in 10 pt font).

Reference list (references and reference list are provided according to the APA (American Psychology Association) standard (see the article requirements); the title written in **bold**, the other text written in normal, 11 pt font).

### REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLES

The volume of the article amounts to five to ten A4 pages.

Eligible papers will be published in the e-collection of the conference articles.
